Your ongoing donations enabled us to send another consignment of 9 barrels of food in late March, and we hope that you have all received our congratulations on the amount of people you helped to feed in Zimbabwe with your donations since Christmas 2008, which was another staggering 10,350 people for a day or 1,035 people for 10 days. God Bless you all!

The plight in Zimbabwe is far from being resolved, and is still worse than when we started God's work back in October 2008. It may be out of the front page news due to other events, and whilst we urge your prayers for all the innocent people caught up in other conflicts etc, we cannot lose sight of the Zimbabwe situation.

We have received such a wonderful response, and people have been so generous with the donation of food and money towards the cost of shipping, and we at Passion for Zimbabwe are aware that we have the great responsibility of ensuring that your donations are sent to the areas most in need and confirming that they arrive safely.

We have, therefore, decided to collect in any food that has already been donated, and then, with God's blessing and funds permitting, ship this food together with the new children's clothes, shoes, school equipment and toys that we have stored from last year when food became the number 1 priority, to two orphanages that we have contact with. We then intend to suspend further shipments temporarily until we are completely satisfied that all of our last shipment of 9 barrels plus the barrels of clothes etc have reached their destination and been distributed to where they have been allocated.

This is not the end of Passion for Zimbabwe's aid effort, but merely a period of consolidation, and we hope that you will all continue to provide the wonderful and valued support and great encouragement for our venture, and continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe, so that we might be empowered and in a position to respond to the future needs of the people in due course, whatever those needs might be at that time.
